

Tasmanian nursing and midwifery scholarships - Applications are now open

The Tasmanian Department of Health, through the Office of the Chief Nurse and Midwifery Officer (OCNMO), offers financial assistance to Tasmanian nurses and midwives undertaking further studies through post registration scholarships. The scholarships help to fund post registration education, training and professional development that enables nurses and midwives to build expertise in their chosen area.

The 2022 scholarships will be awarded based on current and projected workforce requirements and areas of high clinical need.

Priority areas for 2022 include but are not limited to:

- Aged Care
- Emergency
- Infection Prevention and Control
- Intensive Care
- Mental Health
- Midwifery
- Public Health

Applications from other clinical specialties will be considered.
