Day Procedure Suite

Welcome.

We aim to make your visit to Calvary North Adelaide Hospital as comfortable as possible.

On the day of your procedure, **make sure you have all of the relevant cards and paperwork you will require for your hospital admission. Have your escort drop you off, as visitors will be unable to accompany you in to the hospital.** Please check in at the main reception. We estimate you will be with us for 3-4 hours, and we will call your escort to pick you up 30 minutes before your discharge.

From the main reception, a staff member will walk you upstairs to the Day Procedure Suite where your admission process will be completed. You'll be made to feel comfortable here, with warm blankets and televisions for your entertainment. Bathroom facilities are also available. Your belongings will remain with you until your surgery time and will then be securely locked away.

Doctors set the fasting time, admission time and theatre list schedule, so you may be waiting an extended time depending on your place on the list. If you have any questions or concerns please speak to the nursing staff.

Once your surgery is completed and you have recovered, you will be brought to the discharge area of the unit. Here you will be offered a light snack and have your discharge information explained. **The nursing staff will call your escort to advise them of your collection time.**

Access to this car park is via the laneway from Ward Street (next to the Mary Potter Hospice) that runs down the side of the hospital (please refer to map). **When they arrive, they will need to call 8239 9525** and then a nursing staff member will escort you down to the rear car park to meet them.

Calvary North Adelaide Hospital is open 6am-10pm. The rear door near Hudson's Cafe is open 6:15am-6:15pm.

If you are feeling unwell, experiencing chest pain or any respiratory difficulties at any time please alert one of our staff.

If you have any dietary requirements, please make the front desk aware as we have special menus available.

Please refrain from eating or drinking within the waiting area as patients will be fasting for surgery.
