## When should you clean your hands?

Hand hygiene is a general term referring to the use of soap and water or a waterless hand rub to cleanse your hands.

It is important to perform hand hygiene as you enter and leave a healthcare facility and also:

- After going to the toilet
- After blowing your nose
- After smoking
- After handling / patting animals
- Before, during & after preparing food
- When your hands are visibly dirty



# Using alcohol based hand rubs

#### When hands are visibly clean......


- 1. Remove excess jewellery
- 2. Squirt enough hand rub product to cover both your hands
- 3. Roll to distribute over palms, back of hands & between fingers
- 4. Rub hands together until dry



# Using soap and water

#### When hands are visibly dirty......

- 1. Remove excess jewellery
- 2. Wet hands with water
- 3. Apply soap
- 4. Rub all over hands
- 5. Rinse off with water
- 6. Pat hands dry with paper towel
- 7. Dispose of paper towel in bin
