Our location and operating hours

The Wig Service is located in the Medical Centre which is on level three of the new building in Platt Street (south block).

The service operates on two Monday mornings each month. On arrival, you should take a seat in the Wig Service waiting area, adjacent to the wig cabinet in the Medical Centre. A volunteer will then welcome you after you are seated and have a chat about your requirements.

Please note, there are lifts in this building if you do not wish to use the stairs.

The Wig Service is a complimentary service. Donations are always welcome.
