

Concessional car parking for regular and long-term patients and their carers in NSW public hospitals.



Concession rates are available for eligible patients and their carers who require regular or long-term hospitalisation and/or treatment in all public hospital car parks in NSW.

Who is eligible for concessional car parking?

Patients and carers eligible to obtain concession rates when parked in public hospital car parks include:

- (a) holders of a RMS issued Mobility Parking Scheme permit;
- (b) holders of a Pensioner Concession Card;
- (c) holders of a Gold Veterans Affairs Card;
- (d) holders of a Health Care Card;
- (e) ongoing cancer treatment patients;
- (f) patients and their carers who are required to attend the hospital/facility for a course of treatment over a period of time greater than one week:
- (g) patients and their carers attending more frequently than twice weekly, including carers of long term patients who visit frequently;
- (h) cardiac rehabilitation education and exercise class attendees;
- (i) daily dressing outpatients;
- (j) health promotion education class attendees.

Calvary Mater Newcastle has three timed car parks available for patient and visitor use - Platt Street Car Park P1, Edith Street Car Park P2 and Villa Road Car Park P3. Allocated disabled parks are available in all patient and visitor car parks.

At entry to the car parks you will be required to take a ticket at the boom gate. Please remember to take your ticket with you.

How do you claim your concession rate?

Concession rates are available for eligible patients and their carers who require regular or long-term hospitalisation or treatment.

If you are eligible to obtain a concession, validate your ticket at one of five locations throughout the hospital before paying at the pay station. You can validate your ticket at any time.

Locations to validate ticket for concessions:

- Level 3 main foyer opposite the Information Desk
- Calvary Mater Newcastle Emergency Department Admissions (afterhours and weekend)
- Level 2 corridor opposite the entrance to Radiation Oncology
- 4. By the Hospice Reception Desk
- 5. Mater Mental Health Centre Reception Desk (Monday to Friday, 7am-8:30pm, Saturday and Sunday, 8am-8:30pm)
