A Close Community

On historical grounds amidst tranquil landscaped gardens, Calvary Ryde Retirement Community offers permanent accommodation for more than 240 residents living in residential care, respite accommodation and on-site Independent Living Units. Calvary Ryde Retirement Community is a friendly, close-knit community and home to residents of many cultures and backgrounds.

Marian Residential Care is a 52 bed facility featuring single room accommodation with ensuites. There is an activity program five days a week for the resident's enjoyment and an on-site kitchen brings delicious freshly cooked meals to the residents daily.

Mary Potter Residential Care is a 63 bed facility inclusive of a 21 bed dementia specific wing. Residents are housed in a mixture of single, double and four bed rooms, most with garden views.



Dalton Gardens houses 122 Independent Living Units and provides residents with a maintenance free, secure and relaxing lifestyle.

Features

Calvary Ryde offers:

- Qualified care staff, guided by our 125 plus year history of caring
- Access to medical coverage when required
- Dedicated physiotherapy assistants who facilitate specialised physiotherapy care designed to maintain mobility
- Recreational activity officers who design individual and group activity programs aimed at encouraging enjoyment, rehabilitation and promotion of self-esteem.
- Qualified pastoral care staff who care for residents' spiritual and emotional needs
- Chaplain who conducts a daily mass in the village chapel
- Ministers of various denominations who can visit on request
- Hairdressing salon with a qualified hairdresser who is available by appointment
- Specialised menu catering to varied tastes and offering a wide choice of meals
- Secure building
- Access to the beautiful, landscaped grounds



Independent Living

Dalton Gardens

Dalton Gardens contains 122 Independent Living Units, consisting of two and three bedroom villas and apartments and three bedroom penthouse apartments.

All residents of our Independent Living Units also have access to the on-site features of our community.

Dalton Gardens offers:

- Landscaped garden and outdoor areas including gazebo and BBQ area
- On-site chapel and pastoral care services
- Hairdressing salon on site
- Large community entertainment areas including a library, auditorium, reading room, billiards room and a cards playing room
- Regular bus trips and social outings
- 24-hour emergency monitoring system
