## Screening at entrances to CNAH

## Good afternoon

As follow up to the Memo dated 1/4/2020 regarding Screening and Temperature checks for staff, please be advised that the following will be implemented to enable this to occur;

Commencing Thursday $2^{\text {nd }}$ of April
All access to Calvary North Adelaide Hospital is to be via one of the staffed entrances only.
This is to ensure screening of every person entering, a sticker will be provided to confirm this screening. There should not be any person onsite without a sticker denoting screening has occurred. A different coloured sticker will be utilised each day.

## Entrances

- Front Reception Entrance - Staffed 0615-2000 hours
- Rear Entrance (Hudson's Entrance) Staffed 0615-1415 hours \& 2000-2215 hours
- Mary Potter Hospice Front Entrance - Staffed 0800 - 2000 hours
- Kimberley House Entrance - Staffed 0800-1600 Hours.
- Between the hours of 2000-0615 hours, the rear entrance via Hudson's must be utilised, perform hand hygiene at the entrance, proceed directly to the atrium and use the phone to contact the Hospital Coordinator on ext 152 where screening will be arranged. Do not leave the atrium until screened.
- No other entrances to the hospital are to be used. This will be monitored for compliance.

If a person is identified as having a Temperature 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater the following will occur:

- All Staff, VMO, Contractor or Visitor - Temperature Advice Card will be given and the person requested to leave the facility
- Patients - Isolate patient, contact Infection Control Coordinator who will advise next course of action

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter, our aim is to keep out patients and staff safe during this time.
