Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: Update on Visitation Restrictions - Calvary Haydon Retirement Community

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Victoria is evolving. Rates of community transmission are increasing, particularly in Melbourne.

Today, the ACT Health Minister, Rachel Stephen-Smith, advised aged care providers in the Territory that due to increased risk of infection in Victoria, any person who has visited Melbourne in the past 14 days should not be permitted to enter an aged care facility in Canberra. In light of this advice, Calvary has taken the decision to introduce new safety measures at Calvary Haydon Retirement Community.

Due to the potential risk of COVID-19 transmission to residents, their visitors and our staff, the following special restriction is now in place at Calvary Haydon Retirement Community:

- **Visitors from Melbourne will not be permitted entry.** Due to increased risk, visitors who have travelled to or from Melbourne in the past 14 days are currently not permitted to visit the facility.

Our primary responsibility remains the protection of residents and staff. We will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria as well as advice from NSW and ACT Health and lift this restriction when it is safe to do so.
