Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: Update on Visitation Restrictions – Calvary NSW Retirement Communities

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Victoria is evolving. Rates of community transmission are increasing, particularly in Melbourne.

Yesterday, NSW Chief Health Officer, Dr Kerry Chant, advised aged care providers across the state that due to increased risk of infection in Victoria, any person who has visited Melbourne in the past 14 days should not be permitted to visit an aged care facility in New South Wales.

Due to the potential risk of COVID-19 transmission to residents, their visitors and our staff, the following special restriction is now in place:

- **Visitors from Melbourne will not be permitted entry.** Due to increased risk, visitors who have travelled to or from Melbourne in the past 14 days are currently not permitted to visit this facility.

Our primary responsibility remains the protection of residents and staff. We will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria and advice from NSW Health and lift this restriction when it is safe to do so.
