Dear Calvary Patient,

RE: Changes to Visitation Restrictions for South Australian Hospitals

We are pleased to inform you that Calvary is further lifting restrictions on general visitation in our South Australian hospitals. While the COVID-19 situation is improving, infection remains a risk. We would like to thank families and friends of patients for following the rules and keeping everybody safe.

Commencing tomorrow, 1 July 2020, we are further easing visitation restrictions at Calvary Central Districts Hospital, in keeping with the current social/physical distancing rules in South Australia:

- **Any two (2) visitors will be permitted to visit.** Calvary will be permitting visitation of any two (2) visitors per patient at any one time for no longer than two (2) hours.

All other restrictions on visitation, announced 17 June 2020, will remain in place:

- **A single child visitor may accompany an adult visitor.** One (1) child visitor may accompany a single adult visitor, within the maximum of two (2) permitted visitors at any one time. Visits are restricted to the patient's room. Child visitors must remain with their adult carer at all times.
- **Social/physical distancing of a single person per 2 square metres as well as 1.5 metres separation at all times will still be required within the hospital.** We ask for your support and co-operation in ensuring that the number of people within each ward or room is consistent with the social/physical distance guidance in place within the community. Our staff will need to monitor overall visitor numbers within each ward and ask for your support in helping us to do this safely.
- **Screening and temperature checks.** Introduced in April, screening questions and temperature checks for all visitors and staff will continue. If a visitor is found to have an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees celsius or greater, entry will not be permitted.
- **For patients who are at end of life, there may be exceptions to visitation restrictions.** If you or a loved one are receiving palliative care or are at end of life, please contact the hospital to discuss whether an exceptional visitation can be arranged.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Please use the hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and throughout the hospital.

You can assist us by informing visitors of these requirements before their arrival.

We are pleased to be able to take this next step in easing restrictions, and thank patients and visitors for continuing to follow the directions of staff.
