

Are you visiting someone cared for by Calvary?

The COVID-19 situation in Launceston continues to improve.

From 24 June 2020, we have eased visitation restrictions at Calvary St Luke's Hospital.

- **Each patient may nominate two (2) visitors on admission.** Only one (1) nominated visitor may visit a patient at any one time between the hours of 2pm and 6pm daily.
- **One (1) child may accompany a single adult visitor.** Visits are restricted to the patient's room. Child visitors must remain with their adult carer at all times.
- **Social/physical distancing of 1.5 metres separation and one person per 4 square metres is required.** Visitation in procedural areas is not permitted. Where a patient shares a room with another patient, please contact the Nurse Unit Manager before your visit.
- **Screening questions and temperature checks remain in place.** If you have a temperature of 37.5 degrees celsius or greater, entry will not be permitted.
- **Special exceptions for palliative, paediatric or obstetrics patients.** If this applies to you, please contact the hospital to discuss whether an exceptional visit can be arranged.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Please use the hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and throughout the hospital.

We encourage visitors to please call the hospital switchboard before their arrival.
