Dear Resident or Family Member,

**RE: Update on Visitation Restrictions - Calvary Haydon Retirement Community**

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Victoria is evolving. From today, 8 July 2020, the ACT Government has temporarily closed the border with Victoria to contain the spread of infection.

Consistent with the latest ACT Health advice, Calvary is expanding special restrictions on visitors who have travelled to or from any location in **Victoria** in the past 14 days.

**Due to the potential risk of COVID-19 transmission to residents, their visitors and our staff, the following special restriction is now in place:**

- **Visitors who have been in Victoria will not be permitted entry.** Due to growing risk of COVID-19 infection in Victoria, any person who has travelled to or from any location within Victoria in the past 14 days are currently not permitted to visit a Calvary ACT hospital or residential aged care facility.

Our primary responsibility remains the protection of residents and staff. We will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria and advice from ACT Health and lift this restriction when it is safe to do so.
