Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: Update on Visitation Restrictions - Calvary SA Retirement Communities

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Victoria is evolving.

While the South Australian border has been closed to non-residents for some time, South Australian residents returning from other states and territories pose a potential risk of infection to others in the community.

The situation in Victoria is a timely reminder to all our residents, their families and friends that any person returning to South Australia is required to go into self-isolation for a period of 14 days.

- Visitors who have returned to South Australia are not permitted to visit a Calvary hospital or residential aged care facility until they have completed their 14 days of self-isolation.
- If you are unwell in any way or are showing any symptoms of COVID-19, please do not visit our residential aged care facilities.
- Symptoms of COVID-19 include:
 - fever;
 - respiratory symptoms; including:
 - coughing;
 - sore throat; and/or
 - shortness of breath.

Other symptoms can include runny nose, headache, muscle or joint pain, nausea, diarrhoea, vomiting, loss of sense of smell, altered sense of taste, loss of appetite and fatigue.

- Screening questions, temperature checks and proof of Influenza vaccination are required before any person will be permitted to enter a Calvary residential aged care facility.

Our primary responsibility remains the protection of residents and staff. We will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria and advice from SA Health and keep you informed of any developments.
