



IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Update – Restrictions for Vendors and Contractors who have visited Victoria

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Victoria continues to evolve. From 8 July 2020, the NSW and ACT Governments closed the border with Victoria to contain the spread of infection.

Consistent with the latest NSW, ACT, TAS and SA Health advice, Calvary has expanded restrictions on Melbourne travel to include the state of Victoria.

New Victoria Travel Restriction for Vendors and Contractors

Due to the potential risk of COVID-19 transmission to the people in our care, their visitors and our staff, the following special restriction is now in place for all Calvary Hospital and Aged Care Facilities:

Any visiting Vendor or Contractor who has travelled to or from any location in Victoria in the past 14 days prior to 10 July 2020 is currently not permitted to visit a non-Victorian Calvary hospital or residential aged care facility.

We will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria as well as advice from the relevant health authorities and lift this restriction when it is safe to do so.
