Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: Update on Visitation Restrictions – Calvary Haydon Retirement Community

The Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in Australia continues to evolve. With recent outbreaks in Victoria and a concerning number of new cases reported in NSW, community transmission of the virus remains a risk.

Based on the latest ACT Health advice regarding travellers from NSW hotspots, Calvary has introduced new restrictions on visitation at **Calvary Haydon Retirement Community**.

From today, 16 July 2020, the following revised restrictions on visitation will apply:

- **Visitors from NSW COVID-19 hotspots will not be permitted entry.** Due to increased risk, and based on the latest ACT Health advice, visitors who have travelled to or from any NSW COVID-19 hotspot in the past 14 days are currently not permitted to visit this facility.

PLEASE NOTE: Current hotspots (at 09.30 hrs. 16 July 2020) are the Local Government Areas of **Liverpool, Campbelltown, Camden, Wingecarribee** and **Wollondilly**.

Given the rapidly changing situation in NSW, COVID-19 hotspots are updated frequently by NSW Health. For the latest information on NSW COVID-19 hotspots, please visit: www.health.nsw.gov.au/

All other restrictions on visitation, advised 13 July 2020, remain in place. This includes the temporary exclusion of any visitor who has travelled to or from the state of Victoria in the past 14 days.

We will continue to monitor the evolving situation in Victoria and NSW as well as the latest ACT Health advice and update visitor screening criteria and restrictions accordingly.
