

# Are you visiting someone cared for by Calvary?

**The COVID-19 situation in NSW  
continues to evolve.**

**From 28 July 2020, new restrictions and  
visitor requirements are in place at  
Calvary Riverina Hospital.**

- **Any single visitor will be permitted to visit each day.** One (1) person per patient per day may visit for no longer than two (2) hours.
- **Any visitor who has travelled from Victoria within the past 14 days will not be permitted entry.** Visitors from Albury Local Government Area will now be permitted to visit.
- **Visitors will be required to wear a face mask.** Where a visitor does not provide their own mask, the hospital will provide a mask upon entry.
- **One (1) child may accompany a single adult visitor.** Visits are restricted to the patient's room. Child visitors must remain with their adult carer at all times.
- **Special exceptions for palliative, paediatric or obstetrics patients.** If this applies to you, please contact the hospital to discuss whether an exceptional visit can be arranged.
- **Social/physical distancing of 1.5 metres separation, screening questions and temperature checks remain in place.** If you have a temperature of 37.5 degrees celsius or greater, entry will not be permitted.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Please use the hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and throughout the hospital.

We encourage visitors to please call the hospital switchboard before their arrival.
