



IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Update – Restrictions for Calvary TAS employees who have visited South Australia

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in South Australia is swiftly evolving.

Yesterday, the South Australian Chief Public Health Officer announced a series of new cases of community transmission in Adelaide and subsequently the Tasmanian Government has put new border restrictions in place.

Today the Tasmanian Government has advised that any person arriving in Tasmania from South Australia from 7 November 2020, will be required to self-isolate for 14 days.

Effective immediately, any Calvary Tasmania staff member who has travelled to or from any part of South Australia at any time since Saturday 7 November 2020 is currently not permitted to attend the workplace.

- **For employees who reside in Tasmania and have visited South Australia since 7 November 2020 but prior to 16 November 2020, you will be required to take special paid Coronavirus leave and monitor your health in self-isolation for 14 days.** If you are showing or develop any symptoms of COVID-19, please seek testing and medical advice if required.
- **For employees who reside in Tasmania and have chosen to travel to South Australia from 16 November 2020 until otherwise notified, you will be required to self-isolate for 14 days and use the leave types personal, carers or annual leave.** Where paid personal and carers leave and annual leave are not available, the period will be unpaid leave.
