

Are you visiting someone cared for by Calvary?

The COVID-19 situation in South Australia is evolving

To minimise the risk of infection, visitor restrictions are currently in place at Calvary St Catherine's Retirement Community.

- **Any two (2) visitors per resident at any one time will be allowed to visit between the hours of 11am-6pm.** There is no limit placed on the total number of visitors allowed each day. Masks are no longer required.
- **Special exceptions to visitation rules.** Exceptions may apply for visitors of residents at end of life, or who may be experiencing distress. Please speak with the manager of your home to discuss arrangements.
- **Visitors from Victoria or a NSW hotspot are not permitted.** Due to increased risk, visitors who have travelled to any part of Victoria or a NSW hotspot in the past 14 days are currently not permitted to visit.
- **Influenza vaccination is required.** You will be asked to provide proof of your vaccination before entry is permitted.
- **Visiting will be limited to the resident's room.** Social/physical distancing of a single person per 2 square metres as well as 1.5 metres separation at all times will still be required.
- **Screening questions and temperature checks remain in place for all visitors and staff.** A visitor with an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater will not be permitted entry.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Please use the hand sanitiser stations regularly.
