



Are you visiting someone cared for by Calvary?

**The COVID-19 situation in South Australia is evolving.
In order to slow the spread of COVID-19, general visitation
has been temporarily suspended
at Calvary St Catherine's Retirement Community**

- **No general visitation is currently permitted.** Due to heightened risk in the community, no visitors are allowed from 11.59pm 17 November 2020 until further notice.
- **Special exceptions to visitation rules.** Exceptions may apply for visitors of residents at end of life, or who may be experiencing distress, or where a care and support role is provided by a visitor. Please speak with the manager of your home to discuss arrangements.
- **Our staff will be wearing facemasks.** All Calvary staff and any visitor who is permitted entry as a special exception will be required to wear a facemask at all times.
- **Screening questions and temperature checks.** Any person with an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater will not be permitted entry. We encourage you to call your loved one via the switchboard or directly instead.
