

Are you visiting someone cared for by Calvary?

The COVID-19 situation in NSW is currently stable.

To minimise the current risk of infection, visitor restrictions are in place at this facility.

- **Any two (2) visitors per resident will be permitted to visit between 11am and 6pm each day.**
- **Visitors and staff are no longer required to wear a facemask.** Consistent with the latest NSW Health advice, visitors and staff from a NSW area with increased testing must wear a mask.
- **Visitors from South Australia.** Visitors who have been in South Australia in the past 14 days are advised to first contact the facility to undertake special screening before their visit.
- **Special exceptions to visitation rules.** Exceptions may apply for visitors of residents at end of life, or who may be experiencing distress. Please speak with the manager of your home to discuss arrangements.
- **Influenza vaccination is required.** You will be asked to provide proof of your vaccination before entry is permitted.
- **Visiting will be limited to the resident's room.** Social/physical distancing of a single person per 4 square metres as well as 1.5 metres separation at all times will still be required.
- **Screening questions and temperature checks.** A visitor or staff member with an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater will not be permitted entry.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Please use the hand sanitiser stations regularly.
