



IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Update – Restrictions for Calvary TAS employees who have visited New South Wales

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in New South Wales is evolving. The Tasmanian Government has declared the Northern Beaches of NSW a COVID-19 hotspot. Accordingly, the Tasmanian Government has put new border restrictions in place.

Today the Tasmanian Government has advised that any person who has been in the Northern Beaches area of Sydney on or since Friday 11 December 2020, is not permitted to enter Tasmania.

Anyone already in Tasmania who has been in the Northern Beaches area of Sydney is required to self-isolate immediately for 14 days and have a COVID-19 test.

Effective immediately, any Calvary Tasmania staff member who has travelled to or from the Northern Beaches of Sydney since Friday 11 December 2020 is currently not permitted to attend the workplace.

Affected employees are advised to contact their Manager for leave advice. Calvary will continue to monitor TAS Government advice and adjust restrictions, consistent with state authorities.
