



IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Update – Restrictions for Calvary VIC employees who have visited New South Wales

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation in New South Wales is evolving. Accordingly, the Victorian Government has introduced new requirements for people returning to the state from the Northern Beaches of Sydney.

The Victorian Government has advised that any person who has been in the Northern Beaches area of Sydney or any [current NSW COVID-19 case locations](#) on or since Friday 11 December 2020, must get tested and self-quarantine for 14 days from the time of exposure.

The Victorian Government will later today announce further advice for travellers entering Victoria from NSW case locations after midnight on Saturday, 19 December 2020.

Effective immediately, any Calvary Victoria employee who has travelled to or from the Northern Beaches of Sydney or any other NSW COVID-19 case location since Friday 11 December 2020 is currently not permitted to attend the workplace.

Affected employees are advised to contact their Manager for leave advice. Calvary will continue to monitor Victorian Government advice and adjust restrictions, consistent with state authorities.
