



Resident Outings Advice for Families - Calvary NSW Retirement Communities

As you will be aware, the COVID-19 situation in Sydney continues to evolve. **Consistent with the latest NSW Health advice, Calvary is pleased to be able to facilitate resident outings in to the community.**

The health and safety of residents is our first priority. Accordingly, we require families to adhere to the following guidelines during a resident outing.

Keeping you and your loved ones safe

To assist Calvary in managing the risk of potential COVID-19 infection for all of our residents during an outing in to the community, the following guidelines should be observed:

- **The outing should take place in a private residence, preferably outdoors (if weather permits) with a small group of people not showing any symptoms of COVID-19.** No one with cold or flu like symptoms or an elevated temperature (37.5 degrees or above) should attend the outing.
- **Avoid large group gatherings and high risk public locations/venues, including shopping centres, food courts, clubs, pubs and other communal eateries such as cafes and restaurants.**
- **The outing must not occur in the Northern Beaches Local Government Area (LGA) of Sydney or any other location of known COVID-19 cases.** For the latest information on identified NSW Health COVID-19 case locations, please visit [the NSW Government website](#).
- **No one from the Northern Beaches LGA of Sydney should attend the place of the outing.** Any person that has travelled to or been in contact with an individual from the Northern Beaches LGA of Sydney on or after 11 December 2020 should not attend the outing.
- **No one that is awaiting COVID-19 testing results should be involved in the outing.**
- **Social distancing of at least 1.5 metres and a single person per 4 square metres should be maintained at all times.**
- **Mask wearing at all times for the resident attending the outing is strongly recommended.** This extends to while using public (trains, buses, taxis, etc.) or private shared transport (private cars, etc.).
- **Regular hand hygiene should be undertaken.** Please continue to wash your hands well and regularly, using hand sanitiser whenever contact with a surface has occurred.
