

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Update – Restrictions for Calvary employees who have visited Queensland

As you will be aware, the COVID-19 situation in Sydney and Brisbane continues to evolve. Today, National Cabinet has declared Greater Brisbane a national hotspot after the discovery of a UK variant of COVID-19 in a cleaner at a Brisbane quarantine hotel.

Accordingly and effective immediately:

Any staff member that has been in the Queensland Local Government Areas of City of Brisbane, Logan City, City of Ipswich, Moreton Bay Region, Redland City, Lockyer Valley Region, Scenic Rim Region or Somerset Region since 2 January 2021 is required to take COVID-19 leave from work until Monday 11th January 6pm at a minimum, and follow the state and territory specific Health Directives for each region via the websites (list).
