



# Have you travelled interstate?

**In line with Tasmanian Government directives, the following restrictions are currently in place.**

- **Visitors who have been in high-risk areas or premises (as identified by Tas Govt) are not permitted entry.**
- **If you have been instructed to quarantine, self-isolate, or waiting results of a COVID-19 test, you are not permitted entry.**
- **Visitors are permitted one (1) at a time.** A maximum of two (2) nominated visitors per patient will be allowed. Visits must be strictly kept to the patient's room and visitors must adhere to social distancing.
- **Screening questions and temperature checks remain in place for all visitors and staff.** A visitor with an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater will not be permitted entry.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Remember to please use the hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and throughout the hospital regularly.
- **Visitors are required to either sign in on paper register or via the QR code.**
