



Have you travelled to QLD, VIC or NSW?

The COVID-19 situation in QLD, VIC and NSW is evolving. In line with SA Health directives, the following restrictions are currently in place.

- **Visitors who have been in high transmission areas or exposure sites (as defined by SA Health) are currently not permitted entry.** (Eligible exemptions by prior approval process only)
- **Any (2) visitors will be permitted to visit each day.** A maximum of two (2) visitors per patient will be allowed. Visits must be strictly kept to the patient's room and visitors must adhere to social distancing. (Exceptions available for maternity and palliative patients by speaking to manager)
- **Screening questions and temperature checks remain in place for all visitors and staff.** A visitor with an elevated temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or greater will not be permitted entry.
- **Hand hygiene is important.** Remember to please use the hand sanitiser stations at the entrance and throughout the hospital regularly
