Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: Updated Visitor Restrictions - Calvary Haydon Retirement Community

As you will be aware, the COVID-19 situation in Australia continues to evolve. **Today, ACT Health has advised aged care providers that Metropolitan Perth, Peel and the South West regions of Western Australia are no longer considered [geographical areas of risk](#).**

What does this mean for residents and families?

Consistent with this latest ACT Health advice, the following restrictions are effective immediately at Calvary Haydon Retirement Community until further notice:

- **Visitors who have been in Metropolitan Perth, Peel and the South West regions of Western Australia will now be permitted entry.**
- **Visitors who have been in a [specific exposure location in Victoria](#) at the same time as a confirmed case, as listed by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) are currently not permitted entry.**
- **Visitors who have returned from any overseas country (including New Zealand) in the past 14 days are currently not permitted entry.**

All other restrictions on visitations, last advised in our email of 1 February 2021, remain current.

We know that restrictions can cause anxiety for some residents and their families. If you are unable to visit at this time, we encourage you to contact the facility to arrange a [WebEx video call](#) with your loved one.
