



IMPORTANT: SA COVID-19 Update

This afternoon the State Government announced that South Australia will enter Level 4 restrictions on public activity from 12:01am Tuesday 20 July until Friday 23 July, when this will be further reviewed.

Exposure sites

Given the current situation, we ask that you review and closely monitor the [list of exposure sites in SA](#). Please take the appropriate action if required.

Border restrictions

If you have travelled during the recent school holiday period, please be aware of the various restrictions across multiple states. Refer to the [SA Health cross border declaration](#) for specific restriction updates.

Regardless of your vaccination status, if you have returned from travel in the areas outlined in the update above, you must adhere to the additional South Australian requirements in relation to quarantine, testing and restrictions.

Mask wearing

Calvary hospitals and residential care facilities are deemed high risk sites.

All VMOs, staff members, visitors and contractors must therefore continue to wear a mask at all times. A hospital mask will be provided at screening.

All patients should wear a mask when transiting between their room and anywhere else within the hospital. Patients are not required to wear masks when in their room. Some exceptions may apply for children and those that cannot tolerate masks.

All masks must be a hospital issued mask. Please do not wear personal masks from home.
