RE: COVID-19 Outbreak Update for Residents and Families: Calvary Haydon Retirement Community

Further to our update earlier today, we want to inform residents and families that at the time of writing, the number of current active cases has not changed since our notification of this morning: ten (10) residents and four (4) members of staff.

As advised in our notification of this morning, Calvary has been working closely with the ACT Health Public Health Unit to explore the option to provide more freedoms to residents in parts of the home not directly affected by current case numbers.

We are pleased to report that we have made significant progress in working through the detail of our plan with ACT Health, which has at its centre the continued safety and wellbeing of all residents in our care. Residents and families can expect a detailed update on this plan soon.

As the situation evolves at Calvary Haydon, please be assured that our dedicated staff are working hard to keep all residents safe from infection. Our staff are trained in strict infection prevention and control protocols and are providing care while wearing the appropriate PPE at all times.

We will continue to contact the listed person responsible for each resident by phone on a daily basis and email an update with any developments. You can help us to ease anxiety by please sharing this information with other family and friends.
