Dear Resident or Family Member,

RE: COVID-19 Update for Residents and Families - Calvary Haydon Retirement Community

Calvary is pleased to inform residents and families that at the time of writing, the number of current active cases remains ten (10) residents and four (4) members of staff.

No new cases of COVID-19 have been identified at the facility since 2 October 2021.

With the assistance of ACT Health, the re-testing of St Teresa residents and staff and Mary Potter COVID-negative residents and staff will be conducted on site today.

All other residents (of St Patrick, St Margaret and St Francis households) will continue to be closely monitored by our staff for any COVID-19 symptoms and we will respond with isolating a resident and ordering a COVID-19 test in the instance any symptoms are identified.

Residents and families will be notified of any additional case as soon as we have this information. In the instance a resident returns a positive COVID-19 test, the resident, their family and doctor will be contacted directly by the facility and provided with an update on current health and wellbeing.

Our dedicated staff continue to work diligently to keep all residents safe from infection. Our staff are trained in strict infection prevention and control protocols and continue to provide all resident care while wearing the appropriate PPE at all times.

We are conscious of St Teresa and Mary Potter residents who must remain being cared for in their rooms until the close contact status of these households has been lifted. Please be assured that we continue to work closely with ACT Health, and will ease restrictions in movement consistent with residents of other households as soon as it is safe to do so.
