Application Process

- **Application letter** – Submit a typed letter outlining your reasons for applying to Calvary Health Care Bethlehem
- **Curriculum Vitae** – Include two professional referees. Please embed photo into your c.v.
- **Academic Transcript** – Include certified copy of your most recent academic transcript with the legend
- **Clinical Assessments** - Include two certified copies of your most recent 3rd year clinical placement reports
- **Proof of citizenship or Permanent Residency**
