The Calvary Story

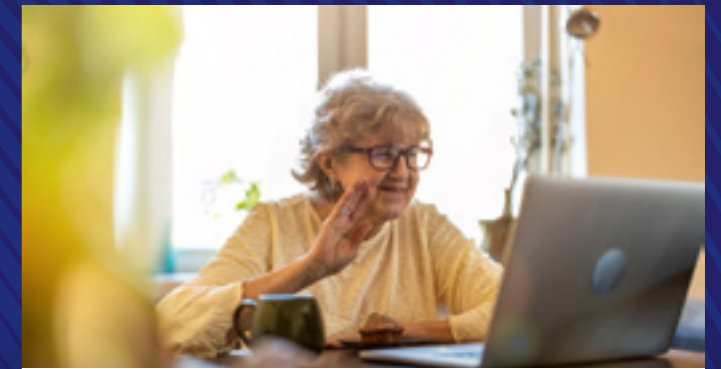
Calvary has provided health care to the most vulnerable Australians, including those reaching the end of their life, since the arrival in Australia of the Sisters of the Little Company of Mary in 1885. We are a charitable Catholic not-for-profit organisation operating across six states and territories in Australia with 14 public and private hospitals, 72 retirement and aged care facilities, a national network of community care service centres and virtual care services.

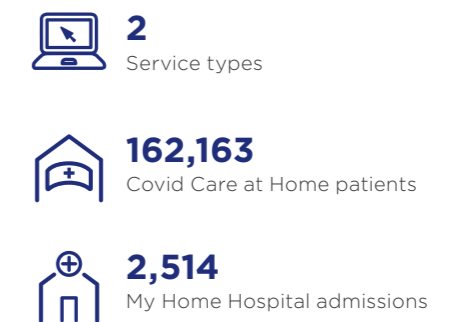
Home care

Calvary supports people in their own homes through a range of aged care, disability and support services to enable independence, improve social connections and promote positive health and wellbeing.



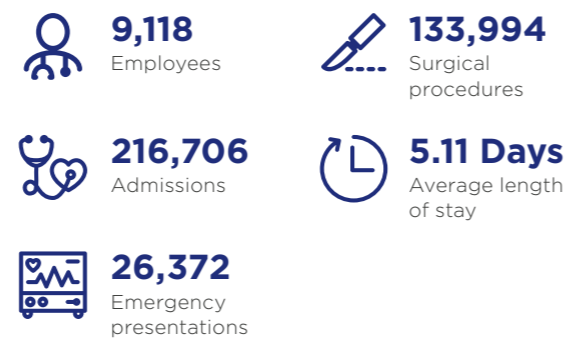
Virtual care

Calvary has developed a virtual care centre concept allowing some acute conditions to be managed at home with a medical-led digital platform with remote monitoring.



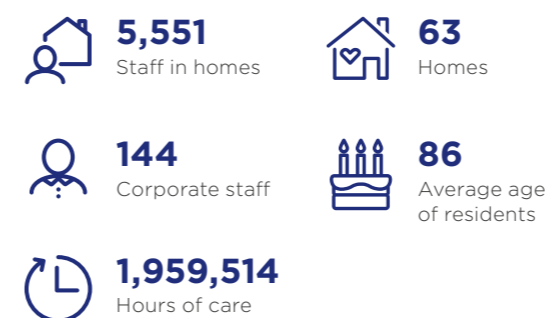
Hospitals

Calvary has increased its retirement living footprint, which respects the freedom to live independently, while often being co-located with an aged care home to make transition to full-time care easier, if required.
